### • 6:30 pm – Financial Report

### • 6:35 pm - Executive Director's Report

Bruce Ross gave an overview of the Executive Director's report and the feedback on the annual meeting and survey results from the meeting's attendees. Regarding the board's decision to create an ad hoc committee on the Wisconsin Waterfowlers Conference, Bruce and Bruce Urben recently spoke with an informed group of conservation organizations and state and federal agencies on moving forward with such a meeting. Planning is still in the early stages as far as the purpose of the conference, where and when it would be held and ways to make it successful. Bruce suggested the board put together an ad hoc committee. WWA completed our waterfowl zone survey with almost 700 responses that has been shared with the WDNR. Bruce, Randy and Bruce Urben had a conference call with George Ermert who has volunteered to be WWA's voice in Madison. Bruce recommended that WWA register as a principal organization for a small fee and will have some reporting requirements. After discussion regarding the investment return and staff time, Dennis motioned, Todd seconded, motion unanimously approved.
